I received your letter and enclose herewith a note in the amount of \$350.00 which please sign and return to us and we will either remit to you the money or credit your account, whichever you so desire.

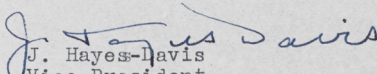
You have a \$1000 Series E Bond which we cannot accept as security because it is a non-negotiable bond and we are not allowed to loan on this kind of a bond.
