Dear Sir:-

Enclosed please find the refilled blank, and another copy of the garage bill on my claim which has been in your hands since last May and was acknowledged at that time to your agent here in Santa Fe, Forrest B. H. Vandervoort. Some weeks ago, prior to the expiration date of this policy, I wrote direct to the Berkely office on finding that the garage had never been paid this bill, as I received no satisfaction or attention to the matter from your present representative in this city. The damage to my windshield in Mexico was covered through the Mexican clause to my policy which was attached prior to my departure for that country.

In the five years that I have carried insurance with you, I have presented only one other claim on which you should have been able to collect complete damage from the other party. This was properly attended to by Mr. Vandervoort, over a year ago. I trust that this present claim of now nearly seven months standing, can be quickly settled as the garage has been carrying this charge on the repairs all this time. The enclosed is the third itemized bill which has been sent in to you.
