Herewith, I am sending you nine photographs from which I wish to have 1000 copies each of postcards similar to my previous orders. Also enclosed are seven old cards for reprints. I realize that these sixteen subjects are not sufficient for one full run, but I hope that you will be able to add them to some other order. Three of the new ones are for a private customer, the other six are for the Museum of Navajo Ceremonial Art, here in Santa Fe. I call attention to the different spelling of the name "Navajo" which is the spelling the Museum wishes. On my own cards I want it spelled with an "h" - "Navaho", the latter is considered correct according to the authorities in whom I have confidence.
