Dear Miss Gilpin:

With deep regret the U.S. Organizing Committee for the Women's International Exhibition has had to abandon its original plans for participation - participation in which you so generously offered to contribute.

Because of the very high expense entailed in sending abread exhibits in the fine arts, and the added difficulties presented by the necessity to obtain export licenses for material valued in excess of \$100, the Committee has reluctantly decided to restrict its exhibit to the subjects of child care and education, scientific investigation and research, literature, and the rele of women as workers and as citizens. These are fields in which material is readily available and does not have the high value of unique works of art.

The Committee appreciates that the U.S. exhibition will lose greatly in aesthetic content and satisfaction under these restrictions, and that the picture presented in Paris of women's achievements in the United States will be neither complete nor comprehensive.

For this reasen, the Committee still hoves to present in the United States an exhibition of material on women's activities, in commemoration of the centenary of the Seneca Falls meeting when American women first publicly demanded full equality as citizens. Plans are now being made and will be announced shortly. The Committee hopes that we may call upon you again in connection with this exhibition.
