Your acceptance of Mr. Kingman's invitation to hang two prints in the invitation section of the 1948 Omaha International Salon of Photography is greatly appreciated.

Prints should be here by about November 12, 1948. The Open portion of the Salon closes November 8, but if your prints are available by the 12th or even the 15th we should have adequate time for making up the catalog before the Salon opens.

The opening of the 1948 International Salon of Photography including both the invitation and the open salon sections, will be held at the Joslyn Art Museum on the evening of November 24, 1948. The Joslyn inaugurated the policy last year of inviting the members of the Society of Liberal Arts and their friends to a special evening reception in conjunction with each new exhibition or a gallery opening. This policy was very well received and is being continued this year as an added feature of our Salon opening.

We expect this to be a great event in Omaha and are eagerly looking forward to the receipt of your prints.
