Glad you beat the ice storm home. I imagine the country is very beautiful now, and wish we could be in Santa Fe.

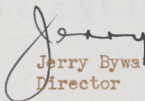
We are still liking the exhibit very much, having good crowds, and will have a large attendance the day before and the day of the large Cotton Bowl game.
