Dear Don:

Thank you for your letter and I am pleased that you are interested in the possibility of having my Rio Grande prints at your Museum. My schedule at present is Dallas into January, then another Texas showing: Wichita, Kansas, in early spring, and the Nelson Gallery in Kansas City in either June or July of next year. This will give you some idea as to what time you could fit in. I hope that you can see the book soon and it will give you some idea of the material. My prints are all on 16 x 20 mounts. The prints themselves ranging in size from 3 1/2 x 4 1/2 to 16 x 20, and there will be from a 125 to 150 prints which can be cut or enlarged at your discretion.

The prints were shown in Colorado Springs in November of last year and Mitch did a superb job of presentation. He can tell you anything you want to know about the prints though I have re-worked the last section of the River since then and feel that I have improved it very much. The book seems off to a wonderful start and I am very much encouraged about it.
