Dear Miss Gilpin:

I shall match your apologies with mine. So much goes on that days slip into weeks before you know it. In regard to your exhibition I hardly know what to say as our schedule is now so filled. I have not seen the book and wonder what dealer here carries it. I shall inquire. There is a bare possibility of our being able to show the pictures the latter part of May but not before that. However, there are a few obstacles which would have to be overcome such as school exhibitions, building plans, etc. The matter of hanging the prints, I should think could be taken care of without the celotex panels. We have recently shown some photographs of the South Pacific by Harry Belgin which were hung by inserting them in grooves between about a three quarter inch thickness of strips connected from top to bottom by thin boards adjusted to the height of the mat. He did not use glass but why can't you use heavy celophane?

I am anxious to have the exhibition here and hope that it may be arranged, if not this year, perhaps another time. Let me know whether the May date would be convenient for you and I can then go into our difficulties with the proper authorities.
