Dear Miss Gilpin:

I am not shipping the paper you ordered until, an answer to this letter is received.

Not knowing what enlarging equipment you are using, I do not know which contrast is normal for you. Please let me know what contrast you want the paper in.

We have not as yet found any way to use a rangefinder for more than one lens but we can make a special footscale for your 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Ektar. We also advise that a solenoid be placed on this shutter if you wish to trip it from the gun. The cost of solenoid and labor would be \$16.98.

I cannot accurately give you the mounting cost of putting your Protar lens in you Ilex shutter as this is generally a factory job. Once in awhile if the diameters of the lenses lend themselves properly to making a sleeve and installing in the shutter, we can do it ourselves but I would not hazard giving an estimate on this work until I actually saw what problems we shall run into.

As yet, I have not found any adapter for taking 3 $\frac{1}{4}$  x 4 $\frac{1}{4}$  film in a 4 x 5 except some adapters that we have on our bargain shelf for glass plates and these are fairly well used and battered.
