Dear Mr. Briggs:-

Under separate cover I am sending you my Protar in the old Compur shutter. Also in the box you will find my Dagor barrel. I want another plange for the Dagor, as I expect to use it also on my 5x7. As for the Protar, I need a shutter that will be accurate for moderate exposures. I do not necessarily need a shutter with built in sync. I would perhaps rather have a solenoid at a future time, but right now one on the shtar is more important. Not only do I have some color work to do this next week, but I cannot spare the Meridian at the same time that the Protar is away, so I shall have to wait until it comes back before sending you the Meridian.

I was rather surprised to find that the Dagor barrel is shorter than the Protar. You can tell from the comparison if you think it would be preferable to have the sleeves made for the Elox shutter rather than get another shutter, but if Compur (or some other make) are now available in this size, perhaps this would be best and quickest.
