Dear Jerry:-

Yes, the prints go to Austin when your time is over. Is that Jan. 15th? I have not heard whether they will be able to show under glass or not. It worries me a bit if they cannot as most of the blue labels are put on with only small pieces of double faced scotch tape. They will have to be more permanently fixed. Could I get some one of your staff to do this for me? Some rubber cement would do, but they must be firmly affixed before they are shown anywhere without glass.

I am having the list re-typed and will attend to the insurance before it leaves you. Miss Winnie Allen, is the one with whom I have corresponded in Austin, archivist at the Library of the University. You doubtless know her. If they do not want the glass, you had best ship it back to me, unless you wish to acquire any of it for your Museum. I paid here, \$7.29 a case, twenty three pieces per case. It is doubtless cheaper in Dallas and you can have any that you wish at \$6. Otherwise, if Austin does not want it and neither do you, please ship it back to me. The big piece, just keep with my best wishes. I am only glad that I got it to Dallas whole.

No wonder you have not been able to do anything with the Indian portfolios! Two years ago, I made inquiry about them and the prices I quoted you were given to me then. I imagine that those figures brought quite a good many copies to light. I am surprised that the Pueblo one can be had for \$60. for that is about its original price. I know of several copies that were broken up and prints sold for \$5. ea. this brought \$250. That is a limited edition of 500 copies. I wonder if it has been reprinted. Please send the Pueblo portfolio back to me, the Kiowa one, belongs to my friend Miss Forster who would like to sell it at its market value. So if you know any one who wants it at \$40. she would be glad to sell it. I would rather keep mine than sell it at \$60.

The minute I hear from Miss Allen, I will let you know her plans
