While the little ones are easier to make in the first place, they are, if anything, more difficult to get good results as far as darkroom processing goes. I have mounted the smaller ones, though I believe that I recall that they may go into a folding frame, but it will be easy enough to cut them down and they do present so much better when they are properly mounted.

The one of Lance with the dog has some movement as you may recall, which shows up more in the large prints than the smaller ones, but none the less it is a gay and spontaneous picture and I hope his mother will like it.

You had selected #4 of the small ones, one where Lance was looking over the saddle. When I enlarged this, I found that his eyes were closed, a detail hard to see in so small a proof, so I have substituted #1 which is quite similar.

I hope you had a nice trip home and that all goes well with both of you. My greetings to Lance.
