Dear Mr. Henbest:-

For nearly a week I have been trying to get a letter off to you. First to confirm my telegram and second to ask you just how many prints you will want for this show.

I wish it were possible for me to come on to Washington for your tea but I fear that that will be impossible. Some details I do want to know. Are you expecting to show the Rio Grande prints as a unit, do you want one or more maps, just how many prints all told will you want for your particular gallery? If I include some other material would you want a few of the best of the Yucatan prints as well? All my mounts are 16 x 20 but there may be some added ones 15x20 as the stock comes in large sheets 30x40 with the obvious reason to cut down slightly on the width. I should like to include the White Sands, for instance, which were deleted from the book for lack of space. I have a good many of the Rio Grande in 16x20 prints, subjects which need the big scale and which spot up a show up nicely. I think it would be best to send you only the number of prints you can surely use. If a few Navaho are included, I think it would be better to have several than just two or three, enough to make a nice group.

I will appreciate hearing from you as soon as possible so that I may commence getting to-gether this added material, some of which I shall have to print specially.

I am glad you had such a nice trip this past summer, and I wish I might see the results.
