Just a line to tell you that I am at home and I hope the mural will be coming in any day. I trust that you have had no difficulty with it.

As the result of five murals of my pictures recently placed in the Santa Fe Book & Stationery Co, in their photographic department, I am getting further inquiries. As yet nothing positive had developed, but I hope that before long something will.

May I ask what you pay for 8x10 fine grain negatives of landscapes suitable for murals? Nearly a year ago my book RIO GRANDE, RIVER OF DESTINY was published by Duell, Sloan & Pearce, Inc. of New York. I am pleased to say that the book is now on the press for the second edition. Perhaps you may care to take a look at it to see the kind of work I do. I am at work on another book which is taking me into very wonderful country. There is opportunity for many more landscapes than I will be able to use in the book, and I should like to find a good outlet for them. I am also working in color, ktachrome, processing myself, and can work in any size from 2 1/2x3 1/4 to 8x10. I do not know what you do in the line of color reproductions. If you are interested in either black and white or color, I shall be pleased to submit some for your consideration.
