Dear Mr. Mosser:-

Several very busy days have prevented my answering your letter immediately. I am happy that you will show my Rio Grande prints, and the dates mentioned in your letter, Dec. 31 to January 28th, 51 will be reserved for you. Should you desire any slight change I will appreciate hearing from you as far in advance as possible as I am working on a schedule for the exhibition for next winter.

The prints are completely covered by insurance and the fees will be small. A portion of the insurance policy which covers transportation and the time in your galleries will be \$4.50. I am not charging any fee other than transportation. In the instance of your showing the prints, as you are so close by, I shall be happy to bring the prints down and help you hang it, if you wish. The prints are packed in three shipping cases, with a fourth case containing plaster letters, and a light package of photostat maps if you wish to include those.
