Dear Stanley:-

In compliance with your request here is an estimate on the photographic work as outlined by you on February 2nd. The time involved is an estimate, but I feel reasonably sure that the work can be accomplished in this time.

To making 1200 photographs of pottery	
estimated time two months @ \$300. per mo.	\$600.00
To film (1250 sheets)	155.00
To paper(contact, single weight)	45.00
To estimated chemicals	30.00
	\$850.00

I asked for a bid from each of the stores handling photographic supplies here in Santa Fe. The Santa Fe Book & Stationery Co. was the low bidder offering me more than a 20% discount on this material. In the event of any materials left over, I shall be glad to take them over at cost.

With the possibility of two or three things materializing for me in the near future, I should like to commence on this project, if these figures meet with your approval. The figures on materials are somewhat higher than you had figured, but film cost is still high even with such a good discount. The excise tax is still on photographic material.

Film now comes packed in lots of 25 and 50 sheets to the box which is the reason for the figure as quoted above. I asked for a price on 1250 thinking this the safest figure, and whatever is left over, I shall be glad to take over.
