Dear Mr. Horgan:-

To confirm our telephone conversation, you will receive my complete Rio Grande show on Jan. 28th or 29th. What in the world ever happened to some of my correspondence, I don't know. Some day I shall probably find it in the wrong file or something. I am most embarrassed to make such confusion. After talking to you, my friend Elizabeth Froster who is here with me said "Havent you a second set of prints you could send to Washington"? As this is not a complete showing, of course I have and I have time to do any filling in I need so all will be well, but I am sorry to have caused you any concern.

For further information to facilitate your hanging of these prints, they are all 16x20 mounts with the exception of the prints of the pictures on the half-title pages in the book. These are smaller which make natural breaks and keep the sections together. Also I have added some photostats of the maps which you can use or not as you see fit. Then I have a set of plaster letters which in previous showings have been used for the three major divisions and again with smaller letters the breakdown to the smaller groups. There is only one possibility that I may not be able to bring the show down. I am at work on a Navaho book and I am waiting the news of the date of a fire dance which is coming up. This I must get to and if the dates coincide I shall send the prints down in good time. I have until Feb. 12th to get the second group ready, so I guess I can squeeze myself out of a bad jam!
