Dear Lance:-

Here are the transparencies and I hope that you will be really pleased with them. Back lighting, especially in color is very tricky but I felt it was much the best lighting for your lovely horse.

If you should want prints of these, or any of them, I have had some excellent prints made by a concern in Tucson. In the course of the next few months I hope to be set up to make prints myself, I just haven't the room in my darkroom right now. But these people in Tucson are doing excellent work.

The price on these 4x5 transparencies is \$25. for each that you wish to keep. A first quality 8x10 dye transfer print would be \$25. on the first print and \$15 on duplicates.

The color shot in action is of course underexposed. Keep it if you want it. Such a shot we should try without attempting the background as well.

Will you ask Crissy if she wants me to make the pictures of her before I go off on a Navaho trip, or will it be time enough when I get back in about two weeks?

Have a wonderful time with that horse, and I will be seeing you later on.
