My Meridian was returned just as I was leaving on a field trip. On unpacking it and testing it, I found the range finder way off, the set screw loose, the tension gone from the little cross spring which holds the extension guide against the pin. I had sent in the camera to replace the pin and for a check on the rangefinder etc. The brass pin which you put in is at an upward angle instead of straight. All of this has caused great inconvenience and on one particular job necessitated borrowing another camera for a series of flash pictures. As I have been unable to spare it to return it to you, and as I have been expecting to leave again on another field trip every day for the past ten days, it has been necessary for me to have it repaired here. It has been promised to me for to-morrow and I expect to get away on Friday.
