Dear Miss Gilpin:

The material which you sent for the forthcoming show has been received in good condition and we are most enthusiastic about the photographs. It is being installed this week by Mr. John Boylan, Head of the Art School of the Museum.

I am looking forward with great pleasure to your visit with me. If you wish to meet me at the Museum, I shall arrange to be there to greet you.
