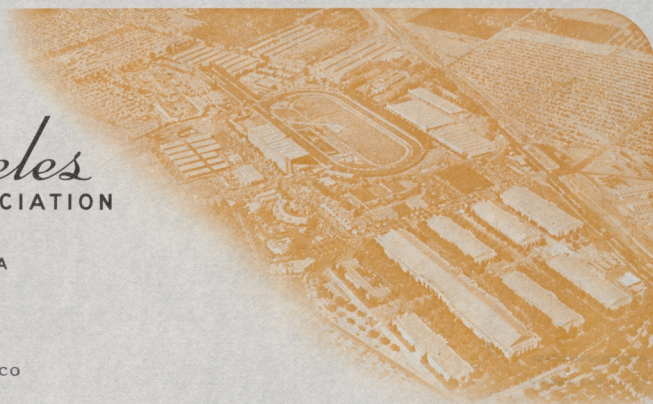

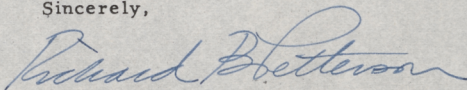
The Fair pays all expenses for shipping and insurance, and provides armed guard protection at all times in the modern, spacious, Fine Arts Building.
