Dear Miss Gilpin:

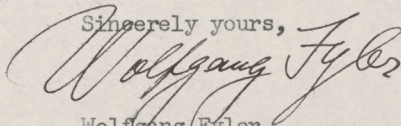
Mr. Kornfeld has asked me to write you about your problem in photographing the Santos.

I quite agree with you that the cupboards present some difficulties. My suggestion would be:

- 1) To take them out and photograph them as single figures against a plain white background--some straight on and some profile so we can make our own layout composition.
- 2) To photograph a group against a white brick wall. However, in doing this, I would select a few of the best ones. There are too many figures in the photograph you have already taken. Three or five--at the most seven would be enough.

We do prefer 8 x 10 for a single composition. For the separate figures against plain white, 4 x 5 would be more economical.
