Dear Mr. Dildilian:-

Last fall when Mr. Ansel Adams was here, he told me of your excellent work in spotting negatives and gave me a part of your address, but he could not remember the street number. He suggested I write to Mr. Jones for it, but I am sending this to Mr. Jones and asking him to fill in the street number.

I have several negatives I want to send out to you, several of them are 4x5 air shots which need a lot of work. Sometimes the vibration of the plane will stir up dust to a frightful degree. I made a flight over the Canyon de Chelly in September, and got a fine set of negatives. Most of them are practically dust free, but two or three are far from it. Mr. Adams said you charged \$3. per negative. Will you advise me if you will be able to do this work for me and approximately how long it will take? I will send the negatives on to you when I hear from you.
