Your letter with the enclosed letter from Mr. Carlson of ARIZONA HIGHWAYS, came several days ago.

Regarding the picture "Monarch of the Range", which appeared in the December last issue of ARIZONA HIGHWAYS, I think Mr. Carlson's suggestion of mounting the pair of pages from the magazine is the best if it is a color print that you wish. I made this picture in color at the same time that I made the black and white for my book RIO GRANDE, RIVER OF DESTINY. I can make you a black and white enlargement at \$10. for 11x14, or \$15. for 16x20. Color prints, that is good color prints of these sizes would be quite costly, \$25. to \$40. for a dye transfer print, and I would not be willing to make to cheaper Printon print for the great loss of color and quality. I have mounted for my own record, the pages from the magazine and they look very well.

However, if you wish any of the above prints, I shall be glad to make them for you. The black and white negative is an original 8x10, and was the pick of the lot that I did. Perhaps your local library will have a copy of my book, or any bookstore could get it for you or show it to you. or I could send you a copy of the book. Perhaps it would interest your son.
