By Thursday I shall have a lot of SANTO material to send you. I have been very much delayed by a local store which promised me 8x10 color film within four days, and which failed to come in from Los Angeles. I wired elsewhere and obtained it. I have made a series of black and whites to show you different groupings and different Santos. Then there will be some 4x5 color with various groupings and lightings, and one or two 8x10 color. If I have not hit exactly what you wish, I hope these will at least give you a good idea as to the material and the possibilities. I am remaking to-day an 8x10 by reflected light entirely which I feel the most preferable for your requirement. My first one was a bit underexposed, and I shall have it for you by Friday as I process it myself.

This is to inform you that I have neraly completed what you wish and when you see these results I am ready to do any others you wish. I have sufficient film on hand so that there would be no further delay.
