Dear Mr. Fyler:-

You will recall that at the time I sent you the 8x10 color transparencies of the SANTOS, that I had had some difficulty with reciprocity failure on long exposures. I had four exposed films that I had not processed knowing that they were under exposed. I put them aside to await time to do some experimenting with development controls when I had the time to do it. The results have been very satisfactory and I am sending them on to you as I am sure that at least two of these are better than the ones I sent in earlier.

I trust that you received the second lot of material sent you several weeks ago. I shall be leaving early next week for a two to three weeks trip into the Navaho country.

I do not believe that it is necessary to put captions with these enclosed transparencies as you have those on similar ones sent you previously.
