I certainly didnt expect to be so long in sending you these proofs etc. But there just seems to be so much to do and the days are never long enough. Also I wanted to send you some samples of Christmas cards, the one good print of the boys so you can see what the finished things will look like etc.

But first, I cant tell you how nice it was to see you and have such nice days with you. It was such fun for us to take you on the two trips, I only wish it could have been more, but you must come again. The boys are such extremely nice youngsters and you must get great pleasure and satisfaction from such nice grandchildren.

In this package you will find two kinds of proofs, 1, the larger negatives which are the red fadable kind, and 2, a set of enlarged proofs (paper is very poor) of the small ones. Also there is one of the larger ones finished as a suggestion for a Christmas card. They are all numbered so you can refer to any you are interested in. I have one suggestion for a little booklet of prints of the small negatives of Frijoles and Acoma etc. I can print these on double weight paper and mount them back to ~~walk~~ and put them in a ring binder of some sort. Or separate prints in a leather folder with cellophane leaves. Should you want two sets of the 16 prints for the boys, I can make them for \$60. The leather portfolios are \$8.50 or a home made booklet would go with the set.

I do hope you will like these. The proofs of the small negatives on the enlarging proof paper are to be judged only for expression and general picture. The quality of this paper is bad, but at least it shows the larger size. The quality of the negatives is good.
