Several weeks ago I wrote you asking the price on printing 35 mm black and white negatives without cutting the roll. I failed to state that these are to be contact prints, not enlargements.

As I am to see the Museum next Monday to continue this job, I wonder if you would be so kind as to send me an immediate reply. Of course I should have written some time ago, but I have been very busy with Christmas work. I enclose a self addressed air mail envelope.

I enclose the transparency of one of the subjects from which you recently made some dye transfers. I want two duplicate prints of this. I note that you informed me that you had done some correction on this whole set. I have wondered just why. The reds were too strong in the prints though not enough to warrant your remaking them. They were satisfactory to my client. Our mountains here, at least those in these pictures are not of a reddish hue. Any way I have an order for a duplicate of this one, and I should like to have one on file. I should also like one Printon of it. I need the comparative prints for future jobs. I also enclose a 2 1/2 x 3 1/2 transparency for a Printon print only. There may be a larger order on several of this set

a little later.

Will you let me know what this order comes
to and I will send you my check.
