We had hoped to receive an answer to our letter of May 21st, giving the details of our plan for the second edition of the Historic American Landmarks Engagement Calendar. We would like to include "The Oldest House in the United States." Enclosed sheets from our 1953 calendar will give you an idea of the format and quality of the book.
