Thank you very much indeed for your letter of the 17th with its invitation to show my Navaho slides at your Albuquerque meeting in November. It is very kind of Mrs. Peck and Dr. Powell to give me such a recommendation.

To date I have shown these slides only three times though there seem to be more in the offing. As the life of color film is limited and also as all my slides are standard 3 1/4 x 4 not 35mm my investment in all this is considerable. I have established a price of \$50. for showing to small groups and \$75. for large groups such as the showing here at the Saint Francis Auditorium. I will be able to furnish a projector but not the screen. A program at a luncheon would be difficult because of the necessity for a dark room. However, you will doubtless be able to arrange this if my fee is within your budget which I hope it will be.

I am just about to leave for some more work on the reservation and will return early in September. I hope that this will all work out to your satisfaction and I do appreciate your invitation.
