We are now making the final arrangements for the State Fair photography show, so I would like to settle the date and arrangements for the judging. I enclose a copy of the competition rules.

Would Tuesday evening, September 13th, be a convenient time for you? I would suggest the following arrangements. Either Mr. Robert Harper, who is vice-president of the camera club, or I would pick you up in Santa Fe at about 5 p.m. and bring you here to Albuquerque, where we would be very pleased if you would be our guest for dinner before going out to the Fair Grounds for the judging. We had hoped that we could hold the judging at our Club meeting room, where we have better facilities, but this unfortunately is against the Fair rules. However, we will do our best to light the prints adequately, and we can take out projection equipment.

We will take you back to Santa Fe afterwards or, if you would prefer it, we will arrange for you to stay in Albuquerque overnight. (Judging 13 classes of pictures may take a little time.)

Either the 12th or 14th, instead of the 13th, would be equally convenient for us. I take it that leaving it later than that would be too late for you. Please let me know which date you would prefer and if any other arrangement at all would be more convenient for you. We are very much looking forward to having you with us.
