Dear Mr. Lowenherz:-

Please pardon my delay in answering your letter of May 4th, but I have been very busy and things get hurried in my desk, or else I just don't find time to sit down to write.

I have done picture sequences, and the minimum charge is \$100. per day "shooting" time plus expenses. I have my own car and the usual rate in this country is 8¢ per mile. Some jobs might be higher depending on the difficulties. As you seem to be specializing in Indians, I assume that you are aware of the difficulties in working with Indians. Sometimes it takes a long time to overcome barriers. And this can often require much time. I know the Navaho pretty well and can usually get results depending on the subject matter. I can work successfully with some of the Pueblos. I have never worked with the Apache groups but I believe I have an entre that would work.

No, I do not use a Rollicflex. I do not like the square shape, I almost always use cut film so that I can develop different lightings to advantage. Depending entirely on the job in hand, I use which camera is best suited to the job and conditions. I have two view cameras, 8x10, & 5x7. A 4x5 suitable either for hand held or tripod use, and a Kodak Medalist, 2 1/2 x 3 1/2 which I greatly prefer to a Rollic.

If you can give me further information as to what you wish, I can then give you a better idea of cost and can tell you if I think I can get the material.

Please pardon my delay in answering your enquiry of May 4th. Have been very busy trying to catch up on work and things got burried on my desk.

In the next two weeks I shall be going over to the Navaho country on a quick trip to fill in one or two missing links in my book. I could do a story for you at that time if you wish, or any time later. The minimum charge on such assignments is \$100. per day. This is in accordance with the A.D.M.F. and of-course plus expenses. I have my own car and I believe that the usual rate is 8¢ per mile in this country.

No, I do not use aolleiflex. I do not like the square shape nor the short focal length lens on close ups, particularly heads. I have two view cameras, 8x10 and 5x7, ; a 4x5 suitable for both heads, special tripod and subjects. I list with them in a rear of great success in miniature scenes, spontaneously in color. ^{These} ~~Results with 2x3 3/4 inch~~ some Pueblo groups. I have not done any work with any of the Apache groups but I believe that I could establish satisfactory working relations. If you can give me more definite information as to what you want, I can tell you if I think I can get results.
