Father Chavez came in to see me yesterday afternoon and we went over the material for the Paul Horgan broadcast with him. We selected some sixteen subjects which should fit in well with the subjects of the discussion. Now the problem is the mechanics of the broadcast. Will you need 8x10 glossy prints, will 16x20 enlargements be sufficient, (I have four or six, now) Will these be made into slides in New York or in California? Or how about my making the slides right here? I cannot let these negatives go out. They are too valuable to me to risk some laboratory working with them. I can furnish 8x10 glossies of any or all, or standard lantern slides if this is the way they will be used.

I realize that time is short and I need all information just as quickly as possible. Either a telegram or phone call perhaps would be best. My number is Santa Fe, 2-0032. and after six o'clock the rates are almost equal a telegram.

I should like as much time as possible to make either slides or prints. Another possibility is loaning my exhibition prints for copying into slides, but in any event I need to know as quickly as possible just how they will be used.
