I thought they were among those returned to you by Herbert's meticulous staff. They were definitely not among those he sent to the Color Corporation of America for printing - these have just been returned to me - and I don't think they are here in the house, but I will continue the search.

Of course I am insured and we can claim loss if necessary, but the money, however pleasant, won't replace them. They are beauties.

By the way, Joe Snyder of Color Corporation reports he has duplicates of the prints made for Berlin and since I am paying the original costs, these duplicates are available at a considerably reduced price.

Your Grass and Feathers is 20" x 24" and the Spinner and the Turtle Dance are both 24" x 30". I wish I might give you these but as you will understand, the costs of producing a job of such magnitude at such breakneck speed are considerably over calm estimates made several months ago. If you think you'd like one of these prints I will get Joe to send them to you quoting his price.

How I envy you off to Indian country now.
