I shall be glad to grant you permission to use the Chichen photograph. At the moment I cannot remember just which one it is. Would you be so kind as to inform me what it is (I do not have a copy of Mr. Kelemen's book). You can either describe it or refer to my "TEMPLES IN YUCATAN" (Hastings House) which has it. Many of these photographs are individually copyrighted as well as the book, so I must know just which one it is. I would rather make you a new print or I may have one on file. The original size is 5x7 and I can make any size you require. However if it is to be reproduced by halftone the size of original does not have to be exact at all.

The minimum charge for a reproduction fee is \$10. As photography is my profession I must make at least the minimum fee.

If you will advise me which picture it is you wish, I will make you a print of it.
