Two years ago Bill Lippincott sent me two photographs of the mobile unit which the Museum of International Folk Art uses for traveling exhibitions. I now would like to have additional photographs of this unit if they are available.

One of the photographs which I have is 5 3/4" by 8" and shows the trailer with a group of school children entering the far end and several children descending the staircase at the near end. The other photograph is 8" by 10" and shows a display case attached to the left wall and resting on a single pipe support, a piece of a framing structure on the right with cord dividers, and in the background a low platform on which is a coffee pot and a small metal bound chest. Above these objects are several molds and part of a label or heading which reads "...N THE HOME".

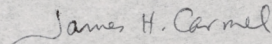
