Dear Mr. Alex:-

Thank you very much for your inquiry regarding the photograph of the Temple of Two Lintels at Chichen Itza. I find I have a glossy print of this on hand and am mailing it to you herewith. This is the only negative I have of the whole building. I made this in 1932. At that time I did not have a wide angle lens and the "bush" was so thick and dense that I could get no further away than I was. I did not go down to Old Chichen when I was there in 1946 as it was a four mile walk and I needed my time on other work. I am interested that you are doing this book on Frank Lloyd Wright. When Mr. Wright was in Colorado Springs (about 1935) he bought five large prints of my Chichen material. This was probably one. I also made some portraits of him then. I will get out the negative and make a print. You might or might not be interested in it.
