Here at last are the ~~first~~ lot of transparencies, eighteen in all. I had to send the second lot I made away for processing while my water was being fixed. Everything is done now and I hope to finish all the rest this week.

You will find some alternates on three of Mrs. Dietrich's paintings. Very delicate ones. One set was a shade too yellow, now the corrected ones are a shade too blue. But I am sure these are easily correctable by the engraver. Same emulsion number, same everything except an 81A filter, which is a very pale yellow.

My mail is not yet in and I hope to hear from you regarding the transparencies I sent you. I have not yet heard from Shostol. That too may be in to-day.

I enclose an invoice on these 18 so that you will have this part of the order delivered.
