Your photographs are magnificent and the editors are just delighted with them. Your bill is also fine and will be paid right away.

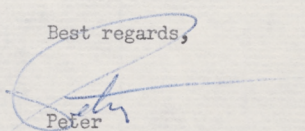
I look forward with great anticipation to the transparencies of Mrs. Curtin's treasures. If they are nearly as good as I remember the originals to be, we will all go ga-ga.
