I am anxious to know if you used the copy negative or the original? Would you be so kind as to advise me? I have an order for another for a private party. The original of this is an 8x10 negative made some twenty seven years ago. It is not the best negative in the world by a long shot. The sky has many marks on it etc etc. But the subject matter is one and the impact such that it is one of my most popular Navaho pictures. I shall make the best possible 11x14 print of this, spot it to the best of my ability and make a copy negative for you. However in spite of the size of the original, I fear it will not be as free of grain as the Yucatan negative. I am really amazed at this PlusXPan film when carefully developed.

I have not yet billed the Folk Art Museum as the bill for the express charges has not yet come. Will you please send me this and I will see that you get a check at once.
