Dear Mr. Rice:-

I have just returned from a ten week trip to Mexico and find your letter of January 13, which was held here and not forwarded to me. To date I have heard from no one.

I see that you state that you have settled injury claims in the other car. I wish to call your attention at once that there was NO COLLISION INVOLVED. I was on the inside lane on the Albuquerque highway in the act of passing a car on my right which was in the outside lane. Suddenly a car appeared ON ITS SIDE out in the Median on my left. It was turning over and quickly piled in behind the car on my right and was able to avoid any collision. I did not touch the car on my left, nor was I touched by this overturning car which must have missed me by inches as it hurtled over behind me. It turned over several times and landed some 25 feet or more beyond the outside lane. There were three passengers in my car all of whom testified to your agent here the following day as to the exact happenings. Also the State police must have seen that my car was not touched. I cannot see how you were liable for anything.

If anyone comes to serve me papers I shall do as you request.
