Your letter of the 22nd reached me yesterday. I am disappointed that there is no preset 135 mm lens for the Optika, and I am wondering if there is the possibility that there will be one later. This length is right for portraiture, the 105mm is too short, the 180 mm a little long. However, I want to try out the camera with the 180mm preset. I enclose my check for \$75. which with the \$50. I have already sent you will make the \$125. Collections seem to be very slow right now, but I am sure that I can take care of the balance within three months. Also, as soon as I decide about it, I will send you the multiscope, which is new, unused and still in its box. I took this in with some other equipment a year or so ago.

I have added the shipping charges to the \$75. as enclosed.
