From my proof No. I and from Dr. Helwig's proof No. I will you please print 8 each of each in Passport size?? I forget the required size. Is it about 3 by four inches?? We may use them and will have them ready in reduced size from these pictures. Our Passports have expired and we will have to start again from tau.
