Your letter of December 2, addressed to Mr. Ed Betlinski was forwarded to us by his Division for handling. Incidentally, Mr. Betlinski is no longer located at Kodak Office although he still is with the Eastman Kodak Company.

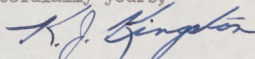
Your request for Kodacolor Transparencies is now being handled by our laboratories and the completed work will be returned to the Santa Fe Book & Stationery Company, in Envelope No. 2176R. We have followed your instructions to the best of our ability.

Our Kodacolor Prints, Enlargements, and Transparency Service is primarily keyed for the amateur customer. Consequently, in order to product prints, enlargements and transparencies at reasonable prices, it is necessary to complete them by semi-automatic means. For this reason, our operators do not pay attention to any color charts that you may have incorporated in the picture area. Also, it is necessary that they work from fixed negative areas. Our laboratories will make a Kodacolor Transparency from each of the negatives that you have designated for printing. These will be returned mounted in 2 x 2 mounts suitable for projection and in cases where there are exposure series, no attempt will be made to identify the negative from which each individual transparency has been completed. It was also necessary that our operators cut your exposure series of six frames into two lengths. The equipment used in making Kodacolor Transparencies will not accept C135 Kodacolor Film in exposure lengths of more than four frames. In most cases it is necessary to cut them in exposure lengths of three to keep the series intact.

In order to avoid any confusion in handling the order, there were several negative strips which were not to be printed. These are being returned at this time under separate cover. They will follow on our Order No. 3451.

It will take our laboratories approximately one week to complete the order. A copy of this letter is being sent to the Santa Fe Book & Stationery Company so that they will be apprised of this work. It will be returned to them by insured mail as you have instructed.
