Replying to your letter of January 11, I called Merle Clark at the Folk Art Museum. He said he would bring in the check for \$500.00 this afternoon. The balance in your account as of this date is \$377.41.

The Note Department had not charged your note for \$350.00 to your account, although I had left instructions that when there was an adequate balance they should run it through.
