The lightest of the view cameras as well as the most compact is still the Deardorff. I have not had any correspondence with them for the past two years but I am sure that the prices have not changed too much over what they were then.

The camera closed is 9 x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$  x 3  $\frac{3}{4}$ . Weight 7 $\frac{1}{2}$  lbs. Lensboard 4 x 4 with rounded edge, full swings and tilts, total extension is 22 inches. Will handle a 90mm lens without recessed lensboard. The camera was \$275.00. The 4 x 5 back for it \$40.00.
