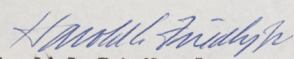
You are invited to participate in our first Photography Invitational Exhibit being held at the Tucson Art Center from May 8 through May 29, 1963. A limited group of outstanding photographers from the southwest region is being invited to submit a number of their photographs and we hope you will accept this invitation. An immediate reply would be greatly appreciated.

Rules:

1. Each photographer is to submit 8 to 10 works. Subject matter is not limited.
2. Black and white and/or color prints -- photographer's choice.
3. Maximum size of mounted photographs including mat or pictures mounted on board and bled is 16" by 20".
4. Tucson Art Center will pay shipping costs. The photographer is asked to pre-pay shipment to us and we will reimburse him.
5. Deadline date - Photographs must arrive at the Tucson Art Center not before March 13 and not later than March 27, 1963.
6. A short biography and an accurate listing of the photographs showing title, size and price, for identification and possible catalogue should be submitted not later than March 27, 1963. All photographs will be for sale unless specifically marked NFS.
7. Gallery Commission - 20% on all sales.
8. Insurance on photographs in transit to the Art Center should be covered by the photographer in the cost of his pre-paid shipment. Insurance on return shipment will be covered by us. The Tucson Art Center will take every precaution against damage or theft but cannot assume any further responsibility. Direct damage will be assumed by the photographer.

We look forward to hearing from you at your earliest convenience.
