Dear Sirs:-

For some weeks I have been intending to write you regarding an additional policy which I was examining. The representative who called on me did not make this policy clearly understood and as I do understand it now, I am just not interested in adding it. I have carried my Policy P 85 & P89 with you for many years. No. 52070459. I wrote in to inquire about your new policy covering medical care at home. Your representative Mr. Beach, did not make it clear that the first two doctor calls ON EACH ILLNESS were to be paid by me and that the policy was not in force until after two calls. I just don't think this policy is worth carrying. At the time he was here I paid him \$22.49 toward adding this policy to my other. Please do not do so.

I know that I am over due on my other policy, and I assume that you have credited me with this amount. Please advise me that this has been done and where I stand on my payments.
