Enclosed please find the 4x5 proof you sent with your letter. Is there a reason why you could not print the whole negative as I requested to fill the 5" dimension with a narrower width? But never mind. This is not important enough to make any difference. The color is some what too blue. The values are O.K. This looks right when viewed through a cc20Y and a cc10 R. This not only cuts the blue but brings up the other colors. Please print 200. I may dry mount these so please harden them well. I had one order from you once that I was not able to dry mount without sticking.

I enclose also the customers choice on the childs portrait. This needs the same correction as the one above. I want 3 8x10 prints, and 4 5x7 prints. Trim slight amount off right side to fit the 5" idmension. I want these unmounted, matte prints.
