The prints would be either 8x10 or 11x14 (approx) I have a print on hand of Chee Dodge as a young man, the early negative by Ben Wittick owned by the Museum of New Mexico. I can get permission to include this with the others though the size is 8x10. I made a copy of the old Photograph of Manuelito which ofcourse I I can print.

The price on these five prints would be \$75.

May I ask how you will display these? I always prefer to furnish such prints mounted, but unframed. the mounts for 11x14s would be 16x20. Similar to those at the Navaho Museum.
